





Mission and Vision

Article 14 – freedom of thought and religion

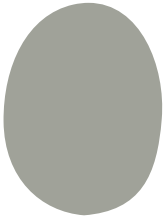
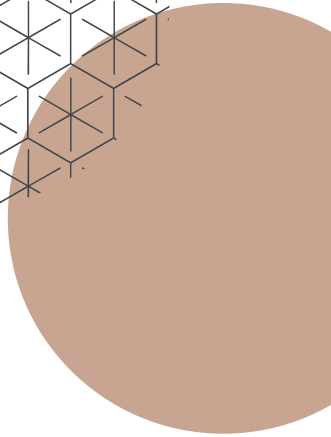
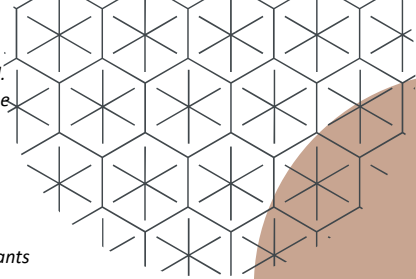

‘Love one another as I have loved you.’


