Focus of the week: "And He said to him, 'Rise and go on your way; your faith has made you well.'" (Luke 17:19)

On Monday, the children heard the story of the Ten Lepers – where all ten lepers were cured but only one turned to thank Jesus. Jesus asked the grateful man: "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?" We explored the people we are thankful for today (e.g. family, teachers, friends, and community members). How can we remember to say "thank you"—not just with words, but through our actions? How can we show our gratitude to God for all the good things in our lives? The children left the assembly thinking about ways they can show their thanks. We encourage you to continue this discussion at home by asking your child who and what they are thankful for today.

Thank you to everyone who showed their support today we have shown racism a firm **NO** with the Red Card! Work this half term has focussed upon encouraging children to understand anti-racism and to challenge racism when they encounter it.

The children have settled very well into their new classes and have coped with new year groups routines and expectations very well. Online Safety

A number of parents have shared concerns about their and other's children's safety online at home. We thank you for their honesty and for helping us make other parents aware.

One issue is around children using devices and communicating with one another very late at night. As well as making you aware of this, which may be happening without your knowledge, we have restricted children's access to a school promoted site (TTRock Stars) beyond a cut off bedtime.

Other parents have made us aware of children accessing a number of AI sites which, despite looking innocent enough to begin with, have exposed children to very inappropriate content such as self-harm, violence and sexual language and imagery. The children will be having a class discussion this week all about Article 31, and how we see it in action every day at school. For example, through opportunities to engage in the arts, including visual art, drama, music, and creative writing - these activities encourage self-expression, build confidence, and develop critical thinking skills. Also, we select our class novels and topics carefully to ensure that the children experience a diverse range of global issues, cultures and ways of life. Through reading and class discussions, children develop empathy, challenge stereotypes, and become more aware global citizens.
