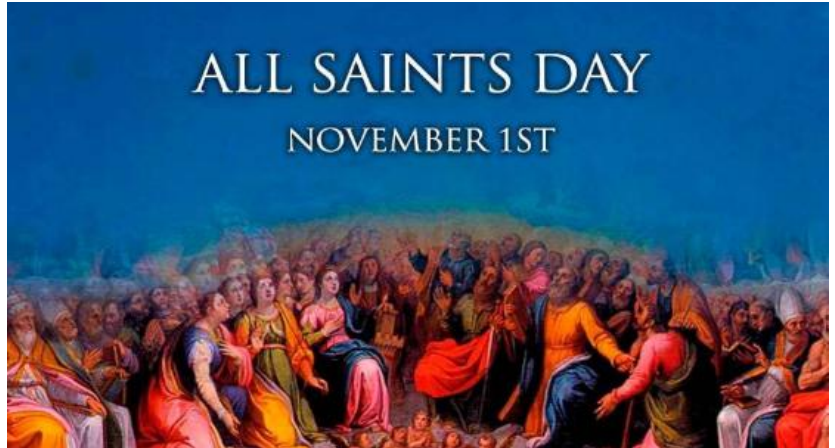

## Get Ready to Rock with Times Tables!

We're excited to announce that we're taking part in the **England Rocks 2025** competition again! This fun, friendly online event is all about making maths exciting and helping our children practise their times tables and division skills.

**What is it?** A UK-wide competition using the **Times Tables Rock Stars** platform. CCJS has done brilliantly in past years: last year we came an impressive 5th in the North West out of 718 participating schools and 14th nationally out of 4,168 schools!

**When?** From **7:30 am on Tuesday, November 18th, 2025** until **7:30 pm on Thursday, November 20th, 2025**.

**Where?** Online at [play.ttrockstars.com](https://play.ttrockstars.com).

**How to Score:** Every correct multiplication or division answer earns points for your child, their class, and the school. The winners are the classes with the highest **average score** per pupil.

To support your child's wellbeing, there is a **daily time limit of 60 minutes** of play that counts towards the competition points. After 60 minutes each day, they can still play and earn coins, but they won't earn competition points.

Please encourage your child to take part and practise, but remember not to

play on their behalf. Let's go, CCJS! Let's rock those times tables!
