Where? Online at play.ttrockstars.com.

How to Score: Every correct multiplication or division answer earns points for your child, their class, and the school. The winners are the classes with the highest average score per pupil.

To support your child's wellbeing, there is a daily time limit of 60 minutes of play that counts towards the competition points. After 60 minutes each day, they can still play and earn coins, but they won't earn competition points.

Please encourage your child to take part and practise, but remember not to play on their behalf. Let's go, CCJS! Let's rock those times tables!

We call them the **4Ts**. If you or your child are weeing more often, constantly thirsty, more tired than usual, or losing weight for no reason, it could be a symptom of type 1 diabetes. If left undiagnosed, type 1 diabetes can be fatal. **If you're experiencing any of the 4Ts, ask your doctor for a blood test immediately. It only takes seconds, but it could save your life.**
