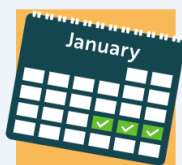

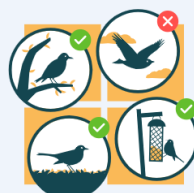
Any nut-free fat balls/ seeds for our bird feeders gratefully received.
