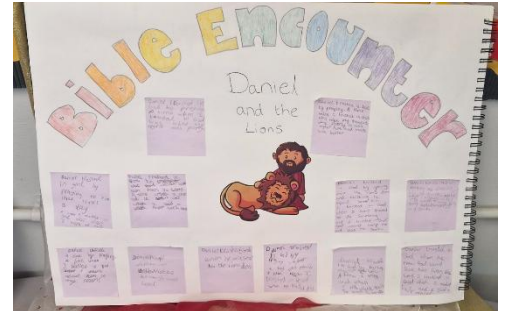

Water safety

Following the tragic number of water-related deaths across the UK over the half-term break, we wanted to take some time to focus on water safety. Some of our classes have already had their dedicated safety sessions in PSHE this week, and the rest will be completing theirs next week. We're teaching the children how to spot hidden hazards like cold water shock and strong currents, and crucially, the RNLI's life-saving "Float to Live" technique (tilt your head back, ears under water, and relax to float). Please help us reinforce this message by talking to your children about this at home. Remind them to never swim in unsupervised open spots like rivers, lakes or reservoirs. This is a national measure to cut costs for families and prevent peer pressure over expensive labels; plain items can be found at supermarkets for as little as £2. If you are missing a plain T-shirt or black shorts, we have brand-new, donated PE kits from Stockport County—just ask at the office.

Finally, please ensure that PE trainers are **not 'astro' trainers where possible**. It has been brought to our attention that the hard studs on some of these trainers are causing scratches and bruises to other children during football games.

With a half term of the year still remaining, we do ask that children still wear proper **school shoes** on non-PE days. If they've outgrown theirs, please check our uniform store for another pair (the shed in the infant playground) or consider looking on used sites such as Vinted for a cheap alternative.
