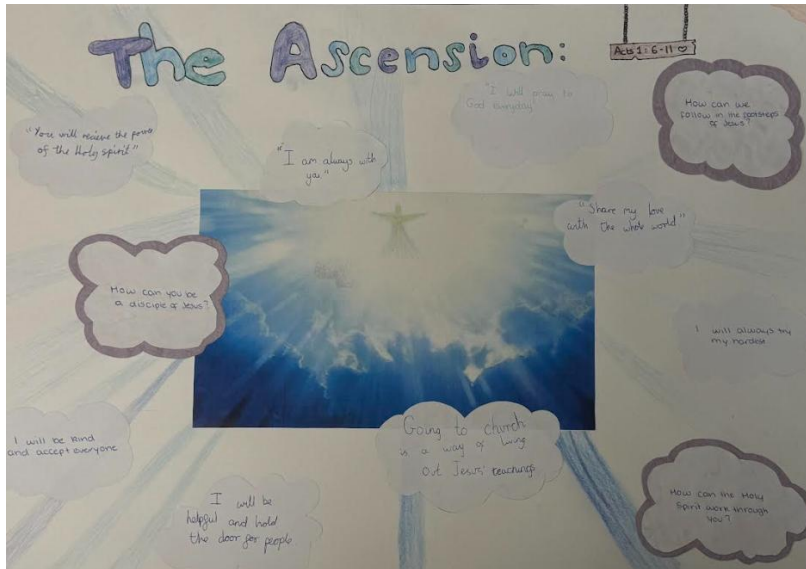

- 11am mass on 14th June Christchurch

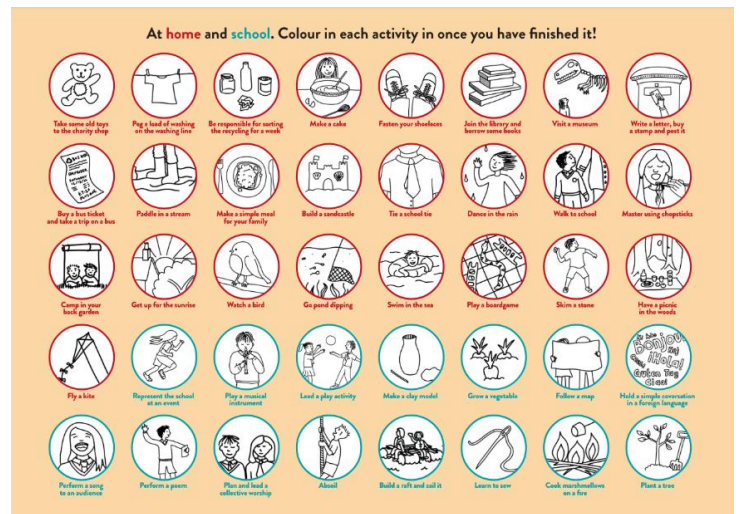
Time To Shine
