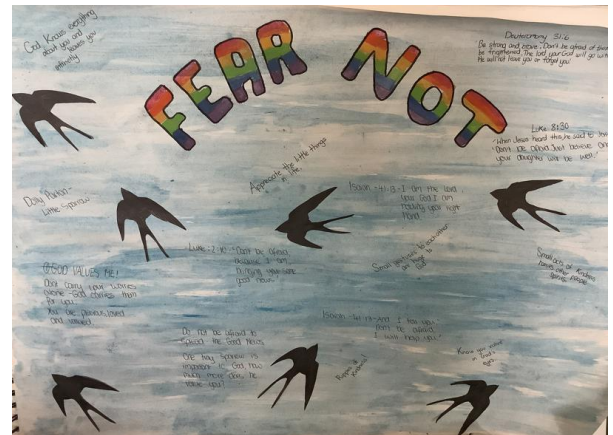

When I go to cubs I do lots of activities like dodgeball and non-stop cricket. I am proud to have sold flowers to raise money for cubs and different charities. Edward.

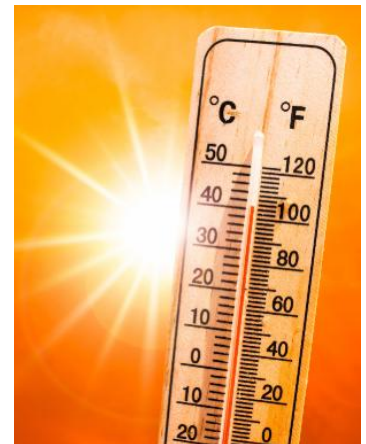
When I play basketball with my team I feel good because I love competitive sports. I was proud when we won a gold medal after a tournament. Khaius.
