When someone important gives a person a very special job to do, we say they are 'commissioned'. Air Tags/ Tracking devices in school and on trips

As technology evolves, we know many families use smart tracking devices like Apple AirTags to keep peace of mind regarding personal belongings.

However, in view of privacy and safeguarding policies, we must clarify that **tracking devices (including wearable wristbands or watches) are not permitted in school** and must be removed from all belongings for **school trips**. This policy is in place due to several important safeguarding and technical factors:

- **Anti-Stalking/ Alerts:** Devices like AirTags are designed with built-in features. When an AirTag is in close proximity to an unfamiliar phone (such as a teacher's or a member of the public's phone) for a period of time, it automatically triggers a "stalking/unknown tracker" alert on that phone, even if it isn't connected to them. As well as this resulting in dangerous communication with strangers, teachers (who carry mobiles on trips in case of emergency) might receive alerts, creating concern and distraction.
- **Safeguarding and Privacy:** We have a strict duty of care to protect all children in our school, including those who may be in care, fostered, or have specific court orders protecting their location. Unregulated tracking can inadvertently compromise the safety of the entire group.
- **Consent:** Tracking children (and therefore the whole group) without a clear, school-managed framework presents legal and privacy challenges that we must avoid.

What this means for upcoming trips: Please ensure your child is not carrying or wearing an AirTag or similar tracker (whether in their rucksack, pockets, or as a wearable accessory) on trip days. Please be assured that we take children's safety on trips very seriously and have protocols in place. If you have specific concerns about your child's wellbeing on a school trip, please communicate these directly with us prior to the trip,
